Release Statement

Part 1: Release to allow EGC to render First Aid and/or seek Emergency Services in the absence of Parents or Guardian.

I fully understand that Erie Gymnastics Center (also known as Team Lightning, Inc.) staff members are not physicians or medical practitioners of any kind. With the above in mind, I hereby release the Erie Gymnastics Center staff to render temporary first aid to my child or children in the event of any injury or illness, and if deemed necessary by the Erie Gymnastics Center staff to call our doctor and seek medical help, including transportation by an Erie Gymnastics Center staff member and or its representatives, whether paid or volunteer, to any health care facility or hospital, or the calling of an ambulance for said child should the Erie Gymnastics Center staff deem this to be necessary.

Part 2: Agreement not to sue or cause litigation versus Team Lightning Inc, its agents or employees. We, the staff of Erie Gymnastics Center recognize our obligation to make our students and their parents aware of the risks and hazards associated with the sport of gymnastics, tumbling, trampoline, cheerleading, dance, acrobatics, and/or specialized sports training. Students may suffer injuries, possibly minor, serious or catastrophic in nature. Gymnastics, Tumbling, Trampoline, Acrobatics, Cheerleading, Dance, acrobatics and/or Specialized Sports Training can be dangerous and can lead to injury or death! Parents should make their children aware of the possibility of injury and encourage their children to follow all the safety rules and the coaches' instructions.

Team Lightning Inc (aka – Erie Gymnastics Center), its coaches and other staff members, will not accept responsibility for injuries sustained by any student during the course of Gymnastics, Tumbling, Trampoline, Acrobatics, Cheerleading, Dance, acrobatics and/or Specialized Sports Training open workouts, or in the course of any exhibition, competition or clinic in which he or she may participate or while traveling to or from the event.

With the above in mind, and being fully aware of the risks and possibility of injury involved, I consent to have my child or children participate in the programs offered by Erie Gymnastics Center and or its representatives whether paid or volunteer.

I also affirm that I now have and will continue to provide proper hospitalization, health, and accident insurance coverage which I consider adequate for both my child's protection and my own protection.

I also understand that it is the parents' responsibility to warn the child about the dangers of gymnastics and injury. The parent should warn the child according to what the parent feels is appropriate. Erie Gymnastics Center will only warn the child through "Safely Messages" and our teaching style and progressions.
